


WORKSHOP ON UNDERSTANDING & MISUNDERSTANDINGS OF JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

A Seminar was conducted on 12th March 2022 on "Understanding & Misunderstandings of Judicial Proceedings" under the valuable guidance of Justice Abhay Oka, Dr. Vijay Chormare & Mr. Murlidhar Nale. One of the crucial aspect, that is the presumption of innocence, which ensures that individuals accused of a crime are considered innocent until proven guilty was explained to the students. This principle protects the rights of the accused and prevents wrongful convictions based on mere accusations. Along with this, Appellate process was also explained by them. The appellate process allows for a review of a trial court's decision. They explained terms such as due process, presumption of innocence, burden of proof, standard of proof, and the role of evidence. This session helped students to understand the rights and responsibilities of parties involved in a legal dispute. They also explained the steps involved, including filing a complaint, serving notices, pleadings, discovery, pre-trial conferences, trial procedures, and appeals. This enabled students to gain knowledge about the roles of different participants, such as judges, attorneys, defendants, plaintiffs, witnesses, and juniors in the judicial procedure.



SEMINAR ON HUMAN RIGHTS AND ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES

On 07th August 2020, we invited Shri. S.R. Bannurmath to deliver online lecture on "Human Rights and Enforcement Authorities." He explained that human rights are inherent to all individuals and are protected by international and domestic legal frameworks. Enforcement authorities play a critical role in upholding and protecting human rights by ensuring compliance with these laws and holding violators accountable. He made students aware about International bodies and mechanisms, such as the United Nations (UN) and regional human rights courts which contribute to human rights enforcement at the global level. These institutions monitor compliance with international human rights treaties, receive complaints, conduct investigations, and issue decisions or recommendations to address violations. Furthermore, the role of law enforcement agencies such as the police and security forces who are responsible for upholding and enforcing laws within a country was explained by him. In the context of human rights, these agencies have a duty to protect individuals from human rights abuses and ensure public safety without infringing upon human rights. He emphasized upon the role played by these agencies in preventing and addressing human rights violations, investigating crimes, apprehending perpetrators, and providing protection to victims. Proper training, awareness of human rights standards, and accountability mechanisms within law enforcement agencies are crucial for effective human rights enforcement.





WORKSHOP ON LAWS RELATING TO RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT (RTI)

On 04th August 2020, Anand Vishwa Gurukul College of conducted a seminar on "Laws relating to Right to Information Act (RTI) and how to use it" via zoom meeting. Shri. Shailesh Gandhi was invited to guide students on this topic. He explained primary use of the RTI Act which is to enable citizens to access information held by public authorities. The meaning of RTI was also explained by him as individuals can request a wide range of information, including government policies, decisions, records, reports, budgets and how it empowers citizens to be better informed about government activities and decisions that affect their lives. Furthermore, he explained how RTI promotes transparency, accountability, and empowers individuals to participate in the decision-making processes of their governments. He also explained certain exemptions which are made to protect specific types of information. These exemptions include information that may harm national security, personal privacy, commercial interests, or prejudicially affect law enforcement or ongoing investigations. Detailed provisions, procedures, and exemptions that govern the right to information in the country were explained by him. This lecture helped students in understanding Right to Information and its uses in a detailed manner.





On 19th May 2020, Anand Vishwa Gurukul College of Law organized a seminar on"Cyber law and cyber- crimes during Covid-19." We invited Adv. Prashant Mali to deliver online lecture via zoom meeting. He explained the situation in pandemic and how it saw a rise in cyber-crimes due to increased reliance on digital platforms for remote work, online education, and social interactions. He also explained various tactics used by cyber criminals such as phishing, ransom-ware attacks, online scams and spreading misinformation related to COVID-19 to target individuals and organizations. The risk of data breaches and privacy violations has grown due to online databases in the covid-19 pandemic. He explained how Cyber criminals may exploit vulnerabilities in remote access systems or misuse personal information for illegal purposes and emphasized upon importance of reporting the cybercrimes promptly to law enforcement agencies and cyber cells established by governments as reporting helps in initiating investigations, collecting evidence, and taking appropriate legal action against cyber criminals. Students were made aware about cyber security and safe online behaviour.
