After giving remedial lectures, with keeping in mind their difficulties of problem solving, the number of students who passed after evaluation were 22. Thus, an outcome of 100 % was achieved through remedial sessions for FYBCOM and FYBBI students for the subject of subject of Accountancy, Mathematics and Business Economics.
