Objective: Plant trees to protect our environment



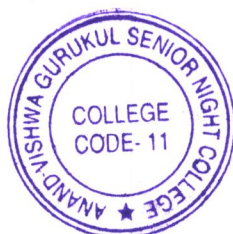
This activity was organized by NSS Unit on the occasion of Tree plantation. Students planted saplings in the area allotted for plantation.

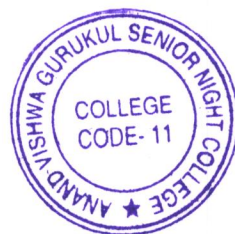
Report:

The cleaning activity helped to restore the original appearances of the statue, making it more visually appealing and improving its aesthetic qualities.



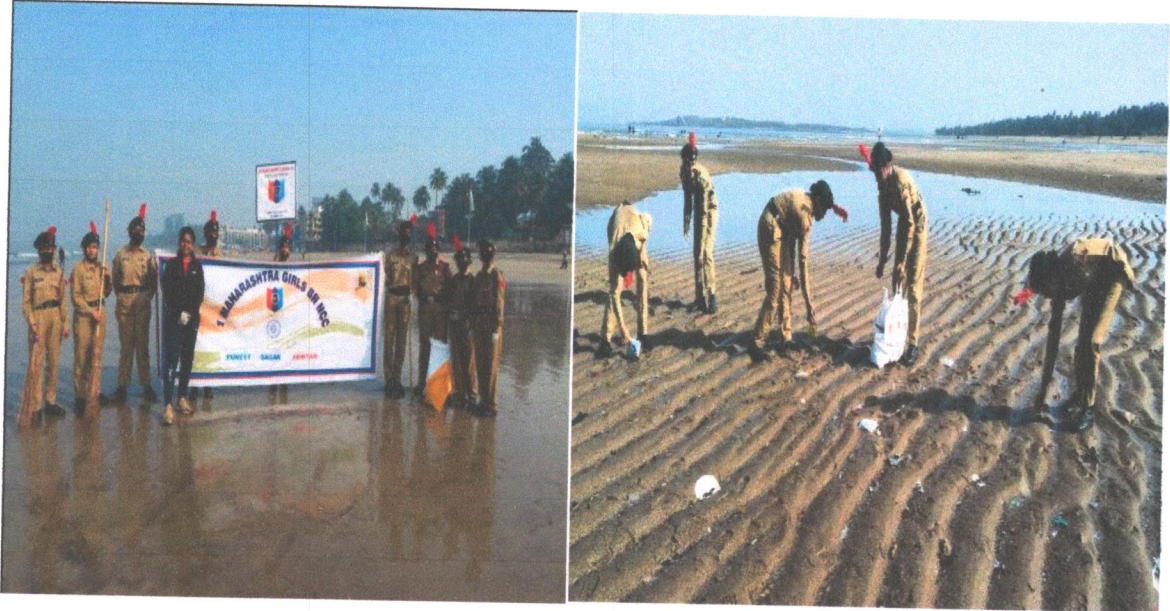

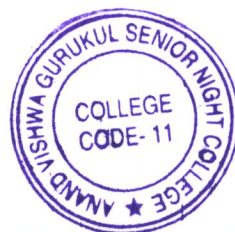

Objective: To create awareness amongst the people of the vicinity.



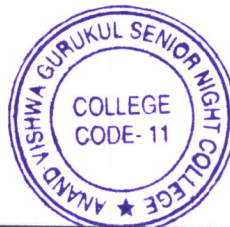


